## Part 2a - Wood Stud Mounting

With the wall plate (1) as a template, ensure it is level, and mark the six mounting holes along the centre lines of the wood stud. Drill six $5 \mathrm{~mm}(3 / 16$ ") diameter holes 80 mm deep. Level the wall plate (1) and secure to the wall using the six long bolts (G) and six washers (E) supplied. Tighten the screws firmly. Do not overtighten.


## Part 2b - Concrete Wall Mounting

With the wall plate (1) as a template, ensure it is level, and mark the six mounting holes. Drill six 10 mm (3/8") diameter holes 90 mm deep. Insert the six anchors (H) into the holes and secure the wall plate using the six long bolts (G) and six washers (E) supplied. Tighten the screws firmly. Do not overtighten.


## Part 3a - Attaching brackets to TV screens with flat back

Centre the brackets vertically on the back of the screen. Select the small (A, B1 or medium C) screws. Attach the brackets to the screen using the four selected screws and washers ( D or E ) at the top and bottom of each bracket. Tighten the screws firmly. Do not overtighten.

## Part 3b - Attaching brackets to TV screens with recessed back

Centre the brackets vertically on the back of the screen. Select the large (B2) screws. Attach the brackets to the screen using the four selected screws, four washers (D), and four spacers (F) at the top and bottom of each bracket. Tighten the screws firmly. Do not overtighten.


## Part 4 - Mounting the flat panel screen

Hook the top of the brackets (2) onto the top ridge of the wall plate (1). Then gently swing the screen down.

NOTE: Always use an assistant or mechanical lifting equipment to safely lift and position heavy equipment.


1. Press down on the brackets once it is installed on the wall plate, it will lock in place.

2. When you need to take the TV down, first pull down on the two strings together to unlock the brackets from the wall plate.

3. Gently swing the TV to install the cables after you have unlocked the brackets from the wall plate.

4. The locking strings can be cut if they are too long and hang below the display.
