Important Safety Instructions

Read all instructions before use and keep for future reference.

- · When left unused for a long period of time, the unit should be unplugged from the wall outlet.
- This product is designed for use in a moderate climate. Do not use or install this unit where it
 would be exposed to direct sunlight or in extreme hot temperatures, or near a radiator, stove or
 appliance that produces heat.
- Do not take this unit to the bathroom, or near a swimming pool. Do not use it where it would be
 exposed to water, moisture, dripping or splashing.
- Do not place near naked flame sources, such as lighted candles.
- If water gets inside the unit, unplug the power cord from the power socket and consult an authorized service technician.
- Do not handle the power cord with wet hands. To avoid electric shock, NEVER touch any internal parts. Repairs/servicing should be left to qualified service personnel.
- When connecting or disconnecting from the power supply, hold the plug but not the cord. Pulling the cord may damage it and is dangerous.
- · Do not drop the unit, spill liquid into it or allow objects to fall in it.
- When plugged in, a very small current will flow. To save electricity and for safety, it is recommended that the product is completely disconnected from the power socket if the unit will not be used for a period of time.
- Consult your nearest dealer when damage, disconnection or contact failure is found with the cord.
- · Do not bend the cord sharply, pull or twist it.
- · Do not modify the power cord in any manner.
- · Do not insert any metallic object into the unit.
- · Unplug the power cord when there is the possibility of lightning.
- The power plug is used as the disconnect device. It shall remain readily operable and should not be obstructed during intended used.
- To completely disconnect the device from the power supply, the power plug of the device shall be disconnected from the wall outlet completely.
- Ambient Temperature should be 0~40°C. Do not store the unit in hot or cold areas.
- Connect the AC adapter to the DC 5V lack, and to the wall outlet.
- Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- In case of malfunction due to electrostatic damage, reset the product by reconnecting the power source to resume normal operation.



1.1 Product Overview



1	POWER () EXIT	Press and hold to power ON/OFF To return to the main menu
2	UP ROTATE	To move up in the menu / thumbnail / option settings To rotate the image counter-clockwise
3	RIGHT NEXT	To move right in the menu / thumbnail / option settings To display the next photo
4	LEFT PREV	To move left in the menu / thumbnail / option settings To display the previous photo
5	ENTER PLAY/PAUSE ►II	To confirm a setting or function To start/pause the slideshow



2.1 Power Adapter

Insert the USB cable into the DC adapter.

2.2 Connecting to Power Supply

Connect the supplied adapter (5V, 1.0 Å) to the DC IN jack, then plug the other end into a power outlet.



2.3 Placing the Picture Frame

Pull out the stand from the back of the unit until the stand is in place.

The picture frame should be positioned horizontally for portrait display.



2.4 Power ON/OFF

Press and hold the (b) "POWER" button on the unit for 3 seconds to power ON/OFF the unit, or press the (b) "POWER" button on remote control to power ON/OFF the unit.



NOTE:

With regards to operation, these instructions are for the REMOTE ONLY. You can also access the operation menus using the buttons on the frame.

3. Operation

This picture frame supports SD/SDHC/MMC memory cards and USB 2.0 flash devices. After inserting a card or USB device, a slideshow of the images will play automatically.

Press EXIT twice to access the Photo, File, Calendar and Setup menus.

Press ENTER to confirm the setting you want.

Note:

- 1. Make sure there are supported picture files in the card or USB device.
- It will take a longer time to buffer the slideshow if the photo file's size is more than 2MB.



3.1 Card and USB

The memory card Selection menu will appear if you press EXIT.

Select the device you wish to use.



3.2 Picture Mode

Press ENTER to access the photo, file, calendar and setup menus. Select "Photo" from the main menu, then press ENTER to enter the picture mode menu. Use ◀▶ to select the picture you wish to display then press ENTER to play the picture in a single window.

Note: you can select the slideshow mode (single window/three windows/four windows) in the SETUP operation.





3.3 File

Select "File" from the main menu, then press ENTER to enter

You can preview all the files in the selected device by pressing ▲ ▼.

3.4 Calendar

Select "Calendar" from the main menu, then press ENTER to enter.

The calendar is displayed and any photos on the connected memory are shown as a slideshow on the left side of the calendar.

Browse the date information using **♦** buttons.



3.5 Setup

Select "Setup" from the main menu, then press ENTER to access to Setup menu. Use ▲ ▼ to select the setting you want to set up.

Options are: Language, Slide Mode, Slide Speed, Photo Effect, Slide Effect, Photo Mode, Display, Set time/date, Set time format, Format built-in memory, Reset Setting and Exit.



Press ENTER to show the sub menu, select with ▲ ▼, then press ENTER to confirm.

- **3.5.1 Language:** English, French, Italian, German, Spanish, Portuguese Swedish, and Dutch
- **3.5.2 Slide mode:** Single window, three windows and four windows
- 3.5.3 Slide speed: 3/5/15/30 seconds,1/5/15/30 minutes and 1hour:

 Use ▲ ▼ to select the speed, press ENTER to confirm, then press ENTER to complete the slide speed setting.
- 3.5.4 Photo Effect: Colour, Mono, Sepia.
- 3.5.5 Slide effect: Random, Split Horizontal in, Split Horizontal out, Jalousie, Split Vertical in, Split Vertical out, Radiation, Surround, Fade, Right refresh, Next Refresh, On Pan, Roll from down to up, Roll from up to down, Brick.
- 3.5.6 Photo mode: Auto Fit, Optimal, Full.
- 3.5.7 Display

Contrast: Press ENTER twice to select. Use ◆▶ to select from 00 (lowest) to 40 (highest).

3. Operation

Brightness: Press ENTER to select. Use **◄** ▶ to select from 00 (lowest) to 40 (highest).

Saturation/Tint: Press ENTER to select. Use ◀ ▶ to select from 00 (lowest) to 40 (highest).

- 3.5.8 Set time/date: Press ENTER twice to select, then use ENTER to set, then use ◄ ▶ to set the time, then select "Save Time" to save the setting.
- **3.5.9 Set time format:** 12/24. Press ENTER to select. Press ▲ ▼ to set, use ENTER to confirm.
- **3.5.10 Format built-in memory:** Press ENTER, use ▲ ▼ to select or unselect to format the built-in memory. Press ENTER to confirm.
- **3.5.11 Reset setting:** Press ENTER, use ▲ ▼ to select or unselect to reset all settings to their default values. Press ENTER to confirm.
- 3.5.12 Exit: Press EXIT.
- 3.5.13 Copy picture operation: In thumbnail interface, press ENTER to preview in full screen. Press SETUP button to enter submenu. You can set image display mode: Save Picture/Rotate/Zoom operation. Select "Save Picture" to save the picture to the built-in memory. (If picture does not copy to built-in memory, format memory first).
- 3.5.14 Delete picture operation: In thumbnail interface, make the cursor stop on the picture you want to delete. Press SETUP button to enter submenu, select Delete File, press ENTER to delete picture.
- **3.5.15 Rotate function:** When you play the picture press ▶ button, then press the Rotate button to rotate the picture clockwise.
- **3.5.16 ZOOM function:** When you play the picture press ►II button, then press the Zoom button to enlarge the picture.
- 3.5.17 Slide Show function: Press Slide Show button to play the picture in slide show mode.

3.6 Stand Instruction

Extend the bracket from the slot of the digital picture frame. Rotate the frame to stand horizontally and lock into place. See illustration.

4.2 Troubleshooting Guide

If you have problems with your player, consult this manual. If you need further assistance, please contact technical support.

· No power:

Check whether the plug is inserted correctly.

Cannot read the card or USB:

Confirm whether there is enough storage room in the card or USB device. Empty devices cannot be read.

· Slide speed is not the same as the setting time:

Check if photo size is too big (the photo can be played normally if the photo size is within 2MB).

Display is either too bright or too dark:

Adjust the brightness or contrast in Setup menu.

· The colour is light or there is no colour:

Adjust colour or contrast in Setup mode.
