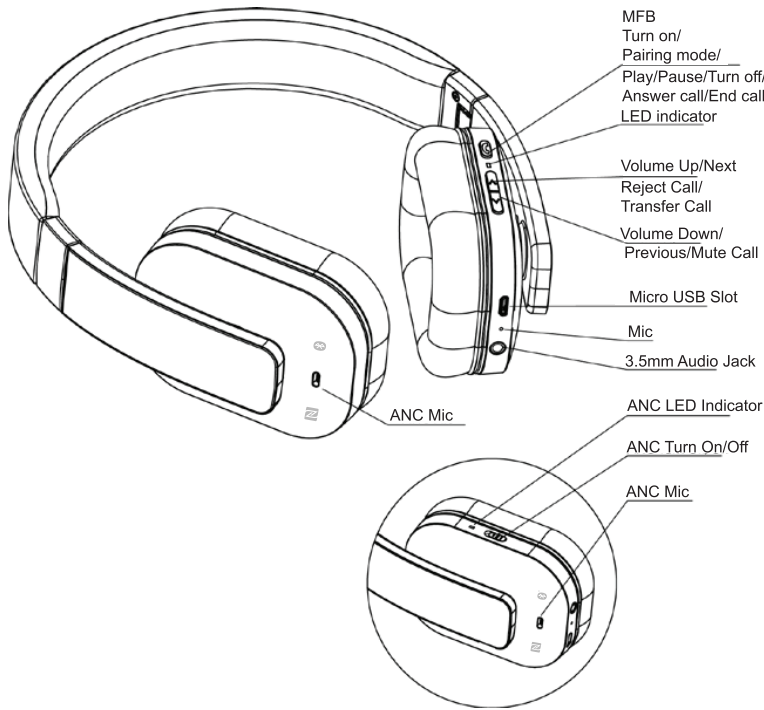
User's Manual

Thank you for purchasing your HeadRush Noise-Cancelling Bluetooth® Headphones. In order to maximize your listening experience, please read the instructions below.

Features

1. Bluetooth® 4.0+EDR.
2. 3.5mm music line-in function.
3. apt-X® audio technology.
4. Supports connecting 2 audio devices.
5. The headphone battery power status is shown on iOS devices.
6. ANC (active noise reduction) function.

Identifying the Parts of your Headphones



Operating Instructions

Operation	LED Status
Power on	Blue LED flashes 2 times
Power off	Red LED flashes 2 times
Pairing	Red LED & Blue LED flash alternately
Standby	Blue LED flashes 3 times in 5 seconds
Incoming call	Blue LED flashes continuously
Low battery	Red LED flashes 2 times every 2 seconds
Charging	Red LED light solid during charging Blue LED light solid when charging complete

Operating Instructions

To	Do this
Power on	Press and hold MFB for 2 seconds
Power off	Press and hold MFB for 3 seconds
Adjust the volume	Press \wedge/\vee button. When the max/min volume is reached the headphones will make a 'tick' sound

Play/pause	Press MFB once to pause. Press again to resume
Next track	Press and hold " \wedge " button for 2 seconds
Previous track	Press and hold " \vee " button for 2 seconds
Answer a call	Press MFB button
End a call	Press MFB button
Reject a call	Press and hold \wedge for 2 seconds
Switching audio devices	During a phone call, press and hold " \wedge " for 2 seconds. The call will switch to your mobile phone. Press and hold " \wedge " for 2 seconds to switch back to the headphones.
Redial previous number	In Standby Status quickly press MFB button twice
Mute a call	Press and hold " \vee " for 2 seconds. Press and hold again to cancel.

Battery Capacity Status

When the headphones are connected to an iOS device, the headphone battery status will appear in the upper right-hand corner.

Charging

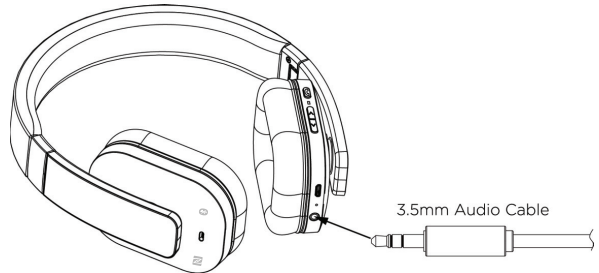
Please charge your headphones fully before the first use. After use, when the battery is low, charge using the included USB cable. A full charge will take about 2 hours. During charging, the red LED light will show. When fully charged, the blue LED light will show.

Reset Mode

Connect the headphones to a computer via micro USB cable. When the red LED flashes, the headphone reset is complete.

3.5mm line-in

Connect the 3.5mm audio jack to your headphones and audio devices.



Active Noise Reduction (ANC) function

When there is excess noise in your surroundings, switch the ANC key to "ON".

Remote Function

To	Do this
Increase the volume	Short press the "+" button
Decrease the volume	Short press the "-" button
Play/Pause	Short press the centre button
Next track	Double-click the centre button
Answer call	Short press the centre button. Short press again to end the call

Pairing (the headphones can connect to 2 devices)

Pairing with one phone or other device:

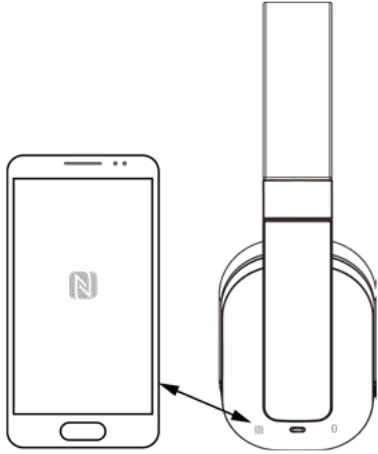
- Make sure the headphone is OFF
- Press and hold the MFB button for 5 seconds to enter the pairing mode
- Red LED and blue LED will flash alternately.
- Locate the Bluetooth® settings in your device and search for the headphone. From the list of found devices, select "HRF 581" and press to connect it. Follow the instructions and enter "0000" as PIN, if required.

Pairing with two phones or other devices at the same time

The headphones can support a multi-connection. It can pair with two smart-phone devices simultaneously and can take a call from either one. After pairing is complete with the first phone, turn the headphones off. Then, re-do the pairing procedure with the second phone. Restart the headphones; they will automatically connect to the phone or device last connected. Short press the “Λ” and “V” buttons simultaneously to enable the multipoint connect function. From the list of found devices, on the second mobile phone, select the headphones “HRF 581” to connect.

Pairing to a phone with NFC function

1. Turn on your phone and ensure the NFC function is activated.
2. Turn on your HRF 581 headphones.
3. Put your phone's NFC area close to the position of the headphones' NFC logo.
4. When your phone confirms the connection, press YES/OK.
5. Once connected, you can enjoy music, play games and watch movies with your headphones.



Sound quality with apt-X® code

Featuring the apt-X code, the headphones can connect wirelessly to any apt-X enabled device. This vastly improves the quality of Bluetooth® streaming, delivering CD-quality sound.
