# 2.0 Soundbar with NFC and Bluetooth®



## **Instruction Manual**

Read all of the instructions before using this soundbar and keep the manual in a safe place for future reference.


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

## **Identifying the Parts**

#### **Main Unit**



#### 1. U button

Switch the unit between ON and Standby mode.

#### 2. 🗗 button

Select the desired play mode.

#### 3. EQ button

Select the preset equalizer.

#### 4. ►II/PAIR button

Start or pause playback (only for Bluetooth\* mode). Press and hold to activate the pairing function in Bluetooth\* mode and disconnect the existing paired Bluetooth\* device.

#### 5. VOL+/VOL- buttons

Increase/decrease the volume level.

#### 6. POWER Indicator

Light up red in STANDBY mode.

#### 7. AUX Indicator

Light up green in AUX mode.

#### 8. Bluetooth Indicator

Light up blue in Bluetooth mode.

#### 9. OPTICAL/ARC Indicator

Light up orange in Optical mode. Light flashes orange in HDMI ARC mode.

#### 10. HDMI @ Indicator

Light up white in HDMI IN 1 mode. Light flashes white in HDMI IN 2 mode.

#### 11. Remote Control Sensor

#### 12. NFC Sensor area

#### 13. AC~Power Plug

Connect a power cord.

#### 14. OPTICAL Socket

Optical input jack.

#### 15. SERVICE ONLY Socket

The USB socket is for service only.
It is not designed to charge smartphones, tablets or similar devices.

#### 16. AUX Socket

Standard 3.5mm audio input jack.

#### 17. HDMI IN 0/@ Socket

#### 18. HDMI OUT ARC Socket

#### **Remote Control**

## 1. (b

Switch the unit between ON and STANDBY mode.

#### 2. SOURCE buttons

Select the desired play mode.

#### 3. VOL+/VOL-

Increase/decrease the volume level.

#### 4. ►II/PAIR

Play/pause/resume playback in Bluetooth® mode.

Press and hold to activate the pairing function in  $Bluetooth^*$  mode and disconnect the existing paired Bluetooth device.

#### 5. |◀◀/▶▶|


Skip to previous/next track in Bluetooth mode.

#### 6. EQ buttons

Select a preset sound effect.

#### 7. MUTE

Mute or resume the sound.




## **Preparations**

#### **Prepare the Remote Control**

The provided remote control allows the unit to be operated from a distance.

- Even if the remote control is operated within the effective range (6m), remote control operation may be impossible if there are any obstacles between the unit and the remote control.
- If the remote control is operated near other products which generate infrared rays, or if other remote control devices using infrared rays are used near the unit, it may operate incorrectly. Conversely, the other products may operate incorrectly.

#### First-time use:



The unit has a pre-installed Lithium CR2025 battery. Remove the protective tab to activate the remote control battery.

#### **Replace the Remote Control Battery**



- 1. Loosen the screw with a screwdriver (not included) to open the battery compartment of the remote control.
- 2. Pull out the battery tray and remove the old battery.
- 3. Place a new CR2025 battery into the battery tray with correct polarity (+/-) as indicated.
- 4. Insert the battery tray back into the slot.
- 5. Tighten the screw with a screwdriver (not included).


#### **Precautions Concerning Batteries**


- When the remote control is not to be used for a long time (more than a month), remove the battery from the remote control to prevent it from leaking
- If the batteries leak, wipe away the leakage inside the battery compartment and replace the batteries with new ones
- · Do not use any batteries other than those specified
- · Do not heat or disassemble batteries. Never throw them in fire or water
- Do not carry or store batteries with other metallic objects. Doing so could cause batteries to short circuit, leak or explode
- · Never recharge a battery unless it is confirmed to be a rechargeable type

## **Placement and Installation**

#### **Placement**

- A. If your TV is placed on a table, you can place the unit on the table directly in front of the TV stand, centered with the TV screen.
- B. If your TV is attached to a wall, you can mount the unit on the wall directly below the TV screen.






#### Wall Mounting (if using option-B)

#### Note:


- Installation must be carried out by qualified personnel only. Incorrect assembly can result in severe
  personal injury and property damage (if you intend to install this product yourself, you must check for
  installations such as electrical wiring and plumbing that may be buried inside the wall). It is the installer's responsibility to verify that the wall will safely support the total load of the unit and wall brackets.
- Additional tools (not included) are required for the installation
- Do not overtighten screws
- Keep this instruction manual for future reference
- Use an electronic stud finder to check the wall type before drilling and mounting



## **Connections**

#### **HDMI Socket**

Using HDMI to connect the soundbar, AV equipment and TV:



#### Method 1: ARC (Audio Return Channel)

The ARC (Audio Return Channel) function allows you to send audio from your ARC-compliant TV to your sound bar through a single HDMI connection. To enjoy the ARC function, please ensure your TV is both

HDMI-CEC and ARC compliant and set up accordingly. When correctly set up, you can use your TV remote control to adjust the volume output (VOL +/- and MUTE) of the sound bar.

- Connect the HDMI cable from the unit's **HDMI OUT (ARC)** socket to the HDMI (ARC) socket on your ARC-compliant TV. Then press the remote control to select **HDMI ARC**.

#### Tips:


- Your TV must support the HDMI-CEC and ARC function. HDMI-CEC and ARC must be set to ON.
- The setting method of HDMI-CEC and ARC may differ depending on the TV. For details about ARC function, please refer to the owner's manual
- Only HDMI 1.4 cables can support the ARC function

#### Method 2: Standard HDMI

- If your TV is not HDMI ARC-compliant, connect your soundbar to the TV through a standard HDMI connection.
- Use an HDMI cable (not included) to connect the soundbar's HDMI OUT socket to the TV's HDMI IN socket.
- 2. Use an HDMI cable (not included) to connect the soundbar's HDMI IN (1 or 2) socket to your external devices (e.g. games consoles, DVD players and Blu ray).


#### **Use the OPTICAL Socket**

• Remove the protective cap of the OPTICAL socket, then connect an OPTICAL cable (not included) to the TV's OPTICAL OUT socket and the OPTICAL socket on the unit.



#### **Use the AUX Socket**


**A.** Use a 3.5mm to 3.5mm audio cable (included) to connect the media player headphone socket to the **AUX** socket on the unit.



**B.**Use a RCA to 3.5mm audio cable (not included) to connect the TV's audio output sockets to the AUX socket on the unit.

#### **Connect to Power**

- Before connecting the AC power cord, ensure you have completed all other connections.
- Risk of product damage! Ensure that the power supply voltage corresponds to the voltage printed on the back or the underside of the unit.
- Connect the main cable to the AC~ Socket of the unit and then into a main socket



- Ensure all connections are connected before connecting to the mains power socket.

## **General Operation**

#### Standby/ON

When you first connect the main unit to the wall outlet, the main unit will be in STANDBY mode.

- Press the  $\dot{\upsilon}$  button on the unit or the  $\dot{\upsilon}$  button on the remote control to switch the unit ON.
- Press the U button again on the remote control or on the unit to switch the unit back to STANDBY mode. The POWER indicator will light up red.
- Disconnect the main unit's plug from the wall outlet if you want to switch off the unit completely.
- When there is no input signal for over 15 minutes, the unit will automatically switch to STANDBY mode.

NOTE: No signal is registered when there is a weak AUX mode signal or if Bluetooth® has been disabled.

#### **Select Modes**

Press the **SOURCE** button repeatedly on the unit or press the AUX, OPTICAL, BT, ARC, HDMI 1, HDMI 2 buttons on the remote control to select the desired mode.

- · AUX mode: Light up green
- OPTICAL mode: Light up orange HDMI ARC mode: Light flashes orange
- · Bluetooth mode: Light up blue
- HDMI 1 mode: Light up white.
   HDMI 2 mode: Light flashes white

#### **Adjust the Volume**

- Press the **VOL+/VOL-** buttons on the unit or on the remote control to adjust the volume.
- If you wish to turn the sound off, press the MUTE button on the remote control. Press the MUTE button again or press the VOL+/- buttons on the unit or on the remote control to resume normal listening.
- While adjusting the volume, the status indicator flashes quickly.
- When the volume level reaches its maximum level, if you press the VOL+ button again, the status
  indicator flashes once. While the volume level reaches its minimum level, if you press the VOL- button
  again, the status indicator flashes once.

#### Select a Preset Sound Effect

While playing, press the **EQ** button on the unit or the NEWS, MOVIE, MUSIC, buttons on the remote control to select between preset equalizers.

## Aux/Optical/HDMI 1/HDMI 2/ARC Operation

- 1 Ensure that the unit is connected to the TV or audio device.
- 2 While in ON mode, press the SOURCE button repeatedly on the unit or press the AUX, OPTICAL, HDMI 1, HDMI 2, ARC buttons on the remote control to select the desired mode.
- 3 Operate your audio device directly for playback features.
- 4 Press the **VOL** +/- button to adjust the volume to your desired level.

**Tip:** While in OPTICAL/ARC/HDMI 1/HDMI 2 mode, if there is no sound coming out of the unit you may need to activate PCM or Dolby Digital Signal output on your source device (eg. TV, DVD, or Blu-ray player).

## **Bluetooth® Operation**

#### Connect to a Bluetooth® Device

The first time you connect your Bluetooth\* device to this player, you need to pair your device to this player.

#### Note:

- The operational range between this player and a Bluetooth device is approximately 8 metres (without any object between the Bluetooth device and the unit).
- Before you connect a Bluetooth device to this unit, ensure you know the device's capabilities.
- Compatibility with all Bluetooth devices is not guaranteed.
- Any obstacle between this unit and a Bluetooth device can reduce the operational range.
- If the signal strength is weak, your Bluetooth receiver may disconnect, but it will re-enter pairing mode automatically.
- 1. While in ON mode, press the **SOURCE** button repeatedly on the unit or the **BT** button on the remote control to select Bluetooth\* mode. The blue indicator will flash slowly.
- 2. The system has entered pairing mode.
- Or press and hold the ►II/PAIR button on the remote control to be searchable. The blue indicator light will flash quickly.

- Activate your Bluetooth device and select the search mode. "Fluid 8052714" will appear on your Bluetooth device list.
- 4. Select "Fluid 8052714" in the pairing list. You will hear "pupu" and the blue indicator will stay solid while the pairing completes.
- 5. Play music from the connected Bluetooth device.

#### To disconnect the Bluetooth function, you can:


- Switch to another function on the unit.
- Disable the function from your Bluetooth device.
- Press and hold the ►II/PAIR button on the remote control or on the unit.

#### **NFC (Near Field Communication) Operation**

Pair your NFC-enabled mobile device directly with this unit by just a single tap.

- 1. Activate NFC on your mobile device and press the SOURCE button repeatedly on the unit or press the BT button on the remote control to select Bluetooth® mode.
- Tap the mobile device on the NFC sensor area of the unit.
- Operate your mobile device directly for playback features.
- To disconnect, tap the mobile device on the NFC sensor area of the unit to disconnect or disable NFC from your mobile device.

**Note:** This NFC function only works with mobile devices that support NFC technology.



#### Tips:

- Enter "0000" for the password if necessary
- If no other Bluetooth device pairs with this player within two minutes, the player will recover its previous connection
- · The player will also be disconnected when your device is moved beyond the operational range
- · If you want to reconnect your device to this player, place it within the operational range
- If the device is moved beyond the operational range, when it is brought back, please check if the
  device is still connected to the player
- If the connection is lost, follow the instructions above to pair your device to the player again

#### Listen to Music from Bluetooth® Device

- If the connected Bluetooth<sup>\*</sup> device supports Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP), you can listen to the music stored on the device through the player.
- If the device also supports Audio Video Remote Control Profile (AVRCP), you can use the player's remote control to play music stored on the device.
- 1. Pair your device with the player.
- 2. Play music via your device (if it supports A2DP).

- 3. Use supplied remote control to control play (if it supports AVRCP).
- To pause/resume play, press the ►II button on the remote control.
- To skip to a track, press the I◄◄/▶▶I buttons on the remote control.

## **Troubleshooting**

To keep the warranty valid, never try to repair the system yourself. If you encounter problems when using this unit, check the following points before requesting service.

#### No power

- Ensure that the AC cord of the apparatus is properly connected .
- Ensure that there is power at the AC outlet.
- Press standby button to turn the unit on.

#### Remote control does not work

- Before you press any playback control button, first select the correct source.
- Reduce the distance between the remote control and the unit.
- Insert the battery with its polarities (+/-) aligned as indicated.
- Replace the battery.
- Aim the remote control directly at the sensor on the front of the unit.

#### No response from the unit

- Disconnect and reconnect the AC power plug, then turn the unit on again.

## Can't find the Bluetooth<sup>°</sup> name of this unit on my Bluetooth<sup>°</sup> device for Bluetooth<sup>°</sup> pairing

- Ensure the Bluetooth function is activated on your Bluetooth device.
- Ensure you have paired the unit with your Bluetooth device.
