





INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the HeadRush HRF 3000 Headphones. In order to maximize your listening experence, please read the instructions below.

- When using the 3.5mm audio cable the headphones are OFF and the operation key has no function
- In order to use the voice function your device must have voice function capability and it must be enabled
- Remote play control (Play/Pause/Next/Prev) requires that your device supports AVRCP Bluetooth® profile

NOTE: The function compatibility may vary among different smartphones or devices. Not all functions are available on all devices.

LED INDICATOR

FUNCTION	OPERATION	INDICATOR
ON	Press and hold MFB for approximately 3 seconds.	Blue LED flashes.
OFF	Press and hold MFB for approximately 3 seconds.	Red LED flashes.
Pair	Press and hold MFB for approximately 5 seconds.	Red and blue LED flash alternately.
OFF	Charging.	Red LED ON.
OFF	Fully charged.	Red LED OFF.

Fully charge your headphones before the first use. Plug the supplied micro USB cable into the micro USB port and then to a USB compatible car or wall charger. A full charge will take about 4.5 hours. During charging, the red LED will remain solid. When fully charged, the red LED will turn OFF.

Pairing with one smartphone or other device:

- Make sure the headphones are ON
- Press and hold the MFB button for 5 seconds to enter into pairing mode

- The red LED and blue LED will flash alternately
- Locate the Bluetooth® settings in your device and search for the headphones
- From the list of found devices, select "HRF 3000" and select to connect
- Follow the instructions and enter "0000" as PIN, if required

USING YOUR HEADPHONES

- 1. For the best sound and comfort, the right fit is very important. Please adjust your headband to make sure the headphones fit snugly and securely.
- 2. Place your headphones on corresponding ear side (R on right ear and L on left ear).
- 3. To ensure your headphones stay in place while doing physical activity, make sure the cord is placed in front of your head and body.

3.5MM LINE-IN

Connect the 3.5mm audio jack to your headphones and audio devices.

TO PLAY MUSIC FROM YOUR PC OR LAPTOP

After pairing the device to your PC or laptop, right-click on the speaker icon on the lower right hand corner of the task bar, select "Playback devices". Under the "Playback" tab, the paired device will show within the list. To connect to it, click on the speaker to set it as default. The audio will start to play from the paired device.

PROTECTING YOUR HEADPHONES

- Keep your headphones clean and free of debris
- DO NOT tug on the cable to disconnect plug from device but rather pull from the plug to disconnect
- DO NOT wrap headphones around a device while it is still plugged in as it puts unnecessary pressure on plug/cord connection

WARNING

- DO NOT insert plug into electric sockets
- Supervise children when using equipment, this product is not a toy
- Listening to headphones at high volume levels, particularily over extended periods of time may damage your hearing
- If you have a pacemaker or other electrical medical devices, you should consult your physician before using this product
- The operation of switching on your Hi-Fi system or plugging in the headphones may cause clicks which at high volume setting may affect your hearing. Therefore always set the volume control to minimum before switching between different sources (tuner, turntable, CD player, etc) or plugging in the headphones
- DO NOT use the headphones while driving or cycling

TROUBLESHOOTING

No sound

- Power ON the headphones and charge the battery
- Increase the volume on your headphones and Bluetooth® device
- Make sure you are using the correct paired device
- Move your Bluetooth® device closer to the headphones and away from any interference or obstructions
- Use a different music source
- Pair a different Bluetooth® device

Poor sound quality

- Use a different music source
- Pair a different Bluetooth® device
- Move the Bluetooth[®] device closer to the headphones, and away from any interference or obstructions

Headphones don't turn ON

- Power ON the headphones
- Charge the battery

Headphones don't pair with Bluetooth® device

- On your Bluetooth® device: Turn the Bluetooth® feature ON and then OFF. Delete HRF 3000 Headphones from the Bluetooth® list on your device. Pair again
- Move your Bluetooth® device closer to the headphones and away from any interference or obstructions
