GETTING STARTED

CONNECTING WITH USB

• Use the included USB cable to connect the wake-up light clock to the USB port on your computer OR use the included 5V power supply to plug into an electrical outlet



Batteries may be used as a backup power source in case of power outages or to prevent loss of settings when moving the unit from one location to another. They may also be used as a main power source.

To install batteries

- Open the battery compartment
- Insert 3 AAA batteries (not included) according to polarity
- · Replace battery cover

NOTE: When batteries are used the following functions are limited:

- Time display is shut off after 15 seconds to conserve power
- All LED functions are unavailable

SETTING THE TIME

- Hold (a), the time indicator will begin to blink
- Press and to adjust hours and press to confirm
 Press and to adjust minutes and press to confirm
- Should the time indicator stop blinking while you are setting the time, simply press @ again

SWITCHING BETWEEN 12H AND 24H CLOCK

• Soft touch (9), 12H or 24H will appear on time display



DISPLAY BRIGHTNESS

Press
 On the back of the clock to cycle through low, high or off



FM RADIO

- Touch to turn the radio ON/OFF
- Hold for 3 seconds to automatically scan through all available FM stations
 Touch to select an FM station
- Press and on the back of the clock to adjust the volume

SETTING THE ALARM

time display



- Hold @ for 3 seconds to set the alarm, the hours indicator will start to
- Press and to adjust hours and press to confirm Press and to adjust minutes and press to confirm
- Should the time indicator stop blinking while you are setting the time, simply press @ again

ALARM SOUNDS

- Press on the back of the clock to select sound
- Use \bigcirc to cycle through the 7 different sounds. Press @ again to confirm
- Sounds 1-5 are soothing sounds, 6 is beeping and 7 is the FM radio station last listened to
- To adjust the volume on the alarm, double tap 🐿 on the back of the clock. The screen will flash "V10". Use the @ and @ buttons on the back of the clock to turn the volume up or down.

DURING ALARM YOU MAY

- Touch (30), the alarm will stop for 5 minutes then sound again
- Press alarm button to turn OFF the alarm

SUNRISE SIMULATION

SETTING THE SUNSET TIME

- Touch © to turn the alarm ON/OFF. ©/© appears/disappears on the time display
- Hold © for 3 seconds to set, the hours indicator will start to blink
- Press ⊕ and ⊕ to adjust hours and press © to confirm
- Press

 and

 to adjust minutes and press

 to confirm
- Should the time indicator stop blinking while you are setting the time, simply press © again

SUNSET SIMULATION

 ® 30 minutes before sunset time the LED will turn ON at 100% brightness and will gradually begin to decrease its brightness and turn OFF at sunset time

LIGHT

- Press ® to turn the light ON
- Press ⊕ and ⊕ to adjust brightness
- Press ® again to enter colour-changing mode
- Press

 and

 to select colour: green, red, blue, purple, orange, indian
- Press @ again to turn the light OFF

WARNING

- DO NOT press two or more buttons at the same time
- To avoid failure, there must be 1 second between each touch of a button
- If there is a malfunction, please unplug the unit for 3 seconds
- If the unit will not be used for long periods of time please remove the batteries
