

IDENTIFYING THE PARTS OF YOUR LIGHT

- 1. Bluetooth®/charge indicator
- 2. MODE button: Switch between Bluetooth® and AUX mode
- 3. Prev track/Volume decrease
- 1. Play/Pause/Answer call button
- 5. Next track/Volume increase
- 6. ON/OFF switch
- 7. Mic
- 8. 3.5mm AUX in jack
- 9. DC 5V charging port
- 10. Reset



CHARGING

Fully charge the speaker before use. It takes about 4 hours to charge the speaker fully. Playing time on a full charge is approximately 4 hours at 70% volume.

- Connect the USB cord (included) to the charging port of the speaker and insert the other end into a port on your computer or similar suitable power source.
- The red LED turns ON, indicating that the battery is being charged. Once it is fully charged, the red LED will turn OFF.

POWER ON/OFF:

- Press and hold the ON/OFF button to turn it on. It will enter Bluetooth® and light mode.
- · Touch top of speaker to control the light
- Press the Mode button to turn the Bluetooth OFF and control only the light

LIGHT MODES

- Warm white light mode has 3 brightness settings. Touch top of speaker to switch between low, medium and high
- A long press on top of speaker will change to Colour Mode. Tap speaker
 to change between colours 5 solid colours and then colour changing
 mode where the light cycles through all the colours. Tap once more to
 turn light off.
- Touch again while music is playing and light will pulse to the beat while changing colours.

NOTE: Speaker and LED lights work independently of each other. They can work together as well individually.

PAIRING

Your Bluetooth® Speaker can wirelessly stream audio from any Bluetooth® enabled device within 27-33 Feet. Simply follow the below steps.

- 1. Turn ON the speaker.
- 2. You will hear a beep and the LED will flash blue. The speaker is now in pairing mode.
- 3. Turn on the Bluetooth® on your device an select "Gadget 8065512" from the list of found devices.
- 4. If required, enter the password "0000".
- 5. Once paired successfully, you will hear a beep and the LED will remain solid blue.
- If you fail to pair your device or you want to pair it with a new device please repeat the steps outlined above.

NOTE: The speaker will automatically pair with previously paired devices provided the Bluetooth® is ON and within range.

HANDS-FREE SPEAKERPHONE

Function	Operation	Button
Answer a call	Incoming call	Press Answer Call button once
Reject a call	Incoming call	Press and hold the Answer Call button
End a call	Incoming call	Press the Answer Call button
Volume increase	During a call	Press and hold the Vol+ button
Volume decrease	During a call	Press and hold the Vol- button

PLAY MUSIC

Function	Operation	Button
Volume increase	Playing music	Press and hold the Vol+ button NOTE: A beep will sound when you reach maximum volume level
Volume decrease	Playing music	Press and hold the Volbutton
Pause	Playing music	Press Play/Pause button once
Play	Playing music	Press Play/Pause button again
Previous track	Pause	Press the Prev button
Next track	Playing music	Press the Next button

3.5MM LINE-IN

- 1. Turn ON the speaker.
- Plug the 3.5 mm audio cable (included) in to the auxiliary port of the speaker. Connect the other end of the cable to the audio device.
- 3. Select your favourite song at the source device.

Note: When the 3.5mm cable is connected to the Speaker, the Bluetooth® will not be available. Many functions (except volume control) like Skip previous track, next track etc can be only controlled through your device while playing music using 3.5mm line-in.

TIPS

- Pressing the Mode button switches between the different functions of the speaker. The modes appear in the following order Bluetooth®/AUX-in.
- When the unit is not in use, turn OFF the device to save the battery power.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible cause	Solution
Low sound level	Source volume too low	Increase volume
	Battery dead	Charge battery
Sound distorted	Low battery	Charge battery
No sound	Audio source OFF	Turn audio source ON
	Speaker OFF	Turn speaker ON
	Speaker volume too low or OFF	Increase volume
	Audio paused	Play media from source

CARE AND MAINTENANCE
