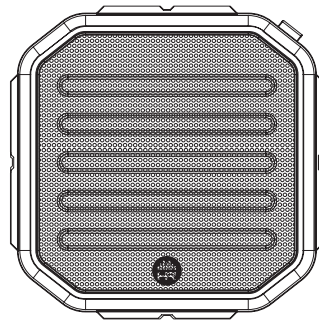

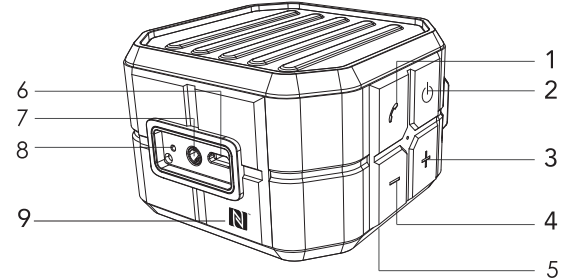
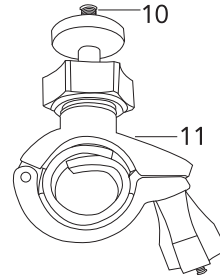

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

You can use this item with iPad®, iPhone®, iPod® devices and many types of smartphones to stream music, and enjoy handsfree calling. In order to get the best results when using this device, please read this manual first before using. This unit has IPX6 rating: Protected against heavy seas – Water projected at all angles through a 12.5mm nozzle at a flow rate of 100 litres/min at a pressure of 100kN/m² for 3 minutes from a distance of 3 metres/10 feet.

Do not submerge in water.

PAIRING

1. Make sure your Bluetooth® audio source is held within 10 metres of your speaker.
2. Turn the speaker ON by pressing the Power ON/OFF button. The LED will flash blue and red alternately, the speaker will beep once in pairing mode.
3. Enable your Bluetooth® device, and make sure it is in searching mode.
4. Select "HR Coast" from the list of discovered Bluetooth® devices on your mobile phone. Once paired you will hear a short beep and the blue LED remain ON.
5. You can now listen to your music or make/receive telephone calls on the speaker.
6. To turn the speaker OFF hold the Power ON/OFF button, you will hear a beep.
7. When streaming music if the Power ON/OFF button is short pressed the speaker will go into pairing mode. Current connected device will disconnect.

Tip: The next time you switch the speaker ON, it will connect automatically as long as your Bluetooth® function is switched ON on your audio device.

When you disconnect the speaker while paired, the blue and red LED will start to blink quickly, the speaker has entered into pairing mode. If there is no device paired within 15 minutes, the speaker will turn OFF.

PAIRING BY ONE-TOUCH CONNECTION WITH NFC

1. Enable the NFC function on your device.
2. Use your NFC-enabled device and touch the NFC logo on the speaker.
3. Confirm the NFC connection on your device. This will vary depending on your device, check your device manual for compatibility.
4. The speaker will beep.

CHARGING

This speaker has a built-in rechargeable Li-Ion battery. Fully charge the speaker before first use. Charge the battery as follows:

1. Connect one end of the included USB charging cable to the charging port on your speaker. Then plug the other end of the USB charging cable into a suitable port on your computer or 5V/1A power adapter (sold separately).
2. The red LED light will turn ON. When the charge is complete the red LED light will turn OFF.
3. It will take 4 hours to fully charge the speaker by PC USB port.

Tip: When battery is low the speaker will beep every 30 seconds and the LED indicator will flash red. Charge the speaker. If the speaker is not plugged in to charge within approximately 5 minutes, it will turn OFF.

OPERATION

1. To increase the volume long press the Increase volume/Next track + button.
2. To decrease the volume long press the Decrease volume/Previous track - button.
3. Short press the Increase volume/Next track + button to skip to the next track.
4. Short press the Decrease volume/Previous track - button to skip to the previous track.

HANDSFREE SPEAKERPHONE

When a smartphone is connected to your speaker follow the steps below to take calls handsfree.

1. When streaming music and there is an incoming call the music will stop and the speaker will ring.
2. Short press the call button to answer the call.
3. Short press the call button again to end the call.
4. Long press the call button to reject the call.

FACTORY RESET

To reset to the factory settings insert the reset pin into the reset hole. The speaker will turn OFF. Turn the speaker ON by pressing the Power ON/OFF button.

LINE-IN

1. Use the supplied 3.5mm cable to connect the speaker directly with your device.
 2. The LED turns solid blue and the speaker will beep. Bluetooth® connection will disconnect.
- Tip:** LINE-IN always takes priority. Make sure the 3.5mm audio cable is not connected during Bluetooth® use.

BIKE MOUNT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove nut from bracket. Position the bracket onto handlebar. Tighten nut, and adjust bracket in the desired position.
2. Position the speaker over the screw on the mount and tighten.
3. Check the speaker and bike mount to make sure both are fastened.

TO PLAY MUSIC FROM YOUR PC OR LAPTOP

After pairing the device to your PC or laptop, right-click on the speaker icon on the lower right hand corner of the task bar, select "Playback devices". Under the "Playback" tab, the paired device will show within the list. To connect it, click on the device to set it as the default device. The audio will start to play from the paired device.

UNDERSTANDING THE LED STATUS LIGHTS

- **When charging your speaker**
 - o Solid red LED=charging
 - o Red LED OFF=charging complete
- **When pairing your speaker to a Bluetooth® device**
 - o Quick blinking blue and red LED=Bluetooth® not connected, ready to pair
 - o Solid blue LED=Bluetooth® connected
- **When connected via LINE-IN**
 - o Solid blue LED=connected

- The volume of the speaker is too low, adjust the volume to an appropriate level
