GETTING STARTED

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Carefully remove neon light from packaging.
2. Open the battery box cover located at base of the neon light.
3. Insert 3 AA batteries (not included) following the polarity (+/-) marked.
(Do not mix old and new batteries; do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries).
4. Close battery box cover.
5. Turn the light ON.

WARNINGS:

- Neon Light is for indoor use only
- Lights are not waterproof, please use in dry and clean place
- **DO NOT** install batteries while the product is in the packaging
- Remove batteries when not in use
- **DO NOT** use outdoors
- **DO NOT** use if product is damaged
- **DO NOT** expose to direct heat, flame or immerse in water
- Protect product from sharp or potentially damaging objects to avoid damage to the Neon Light
