





GETTING STARTED BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Open the battery door.
- 2. Insert 4 AAA batteries (not included) following the polarity markings.
- 3. Replace the battery door.



SELECT 12 OR 24 HOUR MODE

 Press and hold the ① button for 3 seconds to switch between 12 and 24 hour mode

NOTE: In 24 hour mode, PM will not be visible.

SETTING THE TIME

- Press the to button, the display will light up and the time will flash
- Press the button to set the hour
- Press the m button to set the minutes Press and hold for faster advancement
- Press the ① button to exit and save
- After approximately 5 seconds of inactivity, the clock will return to normal time display

SETTING THE ALARM

- Press the (a) button, the display will light up and the numbers on the display will flash
- Press the button to set the hour
- Press the mbutton to set the minutes
- Press and hold for faster advancement
- Press the @ button to exit the and save
- After approximately 5 seconds of inactivity, the clock will return to normal time display

SNOOZE FUNCTION

- Press the (a) button twice, the display will light up and the digits on the display will flash
- Press the m button to set the desired snooze time between 1 and 9 minutes

- Press the a button to exit and save
- After approximately 5 seconds of inactivity, the clock will return to normal time display
- Press the "Snooze" button on top of the clock to temporarily disable a sounding alarm

TURN THE ALARM ON

RUNAWAY ALARM FUNCTION

- Press the [®] on the front of the clock to turn the RUNAWAY feature
 ON
- @ will appear on the display
- The RUNAWAY feature will start after the first snooze
- Press the ^(a) on the front of the clock to turn RUNAWAY OFF. ^(a) will disappear from the display

TURN THE ALARM OFF

- Press the ② on the front of the clock to turn RUNAWAY OFF
- Press the "Snooze" button on top of the clock to temporarily disable the alarm
- Press the button on the front of the clock. The alarm will stop sounding

NOTES AND HINTS:

- Place the clock on the back edge of your night stand no higher than 1m (3 ft)
- The alarm clock will run on hard floors and carpet, however, may experience difficulty with thick rugs
- The alarm clock will runaway and the backlight will flash for approximately 30 seconds
- The clock will spin and rotate to get around obstacles
- The alarm will sound for 9 minutes or until it is turned OFF
- Return the alarm clock to the night stand, do not leave it on the floor
- Press any button to activate the backlight for 3 seconds
- The clock will beep and the display will blink when batteries are low.
 Replace batteries
