GETTING STARTED OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS BATTERY OPERATED

- 1. Carefully remove neon light from packaging.
- 2. Open the battery box cover located at base of the neon light.
- 3. Insert three AA batteries (not included) following the polarity (+/-)
- 4. Close battery box cover.
- 5. Turn the light ON.

NOTE: DO NOT mix old and new batteries. DO NOT mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.

USB CONNECTED

- 1. Connect the USB cable to a wall charger or alternative power source (not included).
- 2. Turn the light ON.

WARNINGS:

- Neon light is for indoor use only
- Lights are not waterproof, please use in dry and clean place
- DO NOT install batteries while the product is in the packaging
- **DO NOT** use outdoors
- DO NOT use if product is damaged
- DO NOT expose to direct heat, flame or immerse in water
- Protect product from sharp or potentially damaging objects to avoid damage to the neon light
- Remove batteries when not in use
